Preliminary Combined Test

Jumps not to exceed 3'7"

Preliminary Combined Test -Open to all horse and rider combinations currently competing or looking to move up to Preliminary

Dressage: USEF 2022 Prelim Test A. Small Arena

Show Jumping: Show jumping jumps will not exceed 3'7"

Modified Combined Test

Jumps not to exceed 3'5"

Modified Combined Test -Open to all horse and rider combinations currently competing or looking to move up to Preliminary

Dressage: USEF 2022 Modified Test A. Small Arena

Show Jumping: Show jumping jumps will not exceed 3'5"

Open Training & Training Rider Divisions

Jumps not to exceed 3'3"

Open Training -Have completed more than two Horse Trials at Preliminary or higher within the previous 24 months.

Training Rider -Have *not* completed more than two Horse Trials at Preliminary or higher within the previous 24 months.

Dressage: USEF 2022 Training Test A. Small Arena

Cross Country: **Please note: Training will run a shortened course due to terrain issues. Approx. 1500 meters at 425 mpm. Timed.

Training Combined Test: Dressage and show jumping same as above; no Cross Country.

Open Novice & Novice Rider

Jumps not to exceed 2'11"

Open Novice - Have completed more than two Horse Trials at Training or higher within the previous 24 months.

Novice Rider - Have *not* completed more than two Horse Trials at Training or higher within the previous 24 months.

Dressage: USEF 2022 Novice Test A. Small Arena

Cross Country: Approximately 16 -18 obstacles. Approximately 1800 meters at 350 mpm. Timed.

Novice Combined Test: Dressage and show jumping same as above; no Cross Country.

**Open Beginner Novice & Beginner Novice Rider
Jumps not to exceed 2'7"**

Open Beginner Novice -Have completed more than two Horse Trials at Novice or higher within the previous 24 months.

Beginner Novice Rider -Have *not* completed more than two Horse Trials at Novice or higher within previous 24 months.

Dressage: USEF 2022 Beginner Novice Test A. Small Arena

Cross Country: Approximately 15 obstacles. Approximately 1500 meters at 300 mpm. Timed.

Beginner Novice Combined Test: Dressage and show jumping same as above; no Cross Country.

**Open Introductory Novice & Introductory Novice Rider
Jumps not to exceed 2'**

Open Introductory Novice- Open to horse and rider combinations that have not completed more than two horse trials at the beginner novice level in the last 12 months.

Introductory Novice Rider- Have not completed more than two Horse Trials at Beginner Novice or higher within previous 24 months.

Dressage: USEA 2022 Starter Test. Small Arena.

Cross Country: Approximately 10- 12 obstacles. Approximately 1500 meters. Not timed.

Introductory Combined Test: Dressage and show jumping same as above; no Cross Country.

**Cross Rails Combined Test
Jumps not to exceed 18" (NO XC)**

Cross Rails Combined Test: Open to all horse & rider combinations wanting to gain knowledge & experience in the sport of eventing.

Dressage: USDF 2023 Intro. Level Test B. Small Arena.

**Tadpole Combined Test
Jumps are poles on the ground (No XC)**

Tadpole Combined Test- Open to all horse & rider combinations wanting to gain knowledge & experience in the sport of eventing.

Dressage: USDF 2023 Intro. Level Test A. Small Arena.

All divisions will be split junior/senior if entries warrant.



Cross Country Courses

Slightly rolling, mostly open terrain. New and inviting fences at all levels.
Average difficulty for riders with experience at this level.

General Conditions and Rules

1. There will be six ribbons places per division.
2. Show is limited to 150 entries. Enter early. Entries will close early if limit is reached. Entries will then be waitlisted.
3. No refunds after closing date without veterinary certificate; refunds before closing date minus \$25 office fee.
4. Horses may NOT be entered in more than one level of horse trials competition. Combined tests competitors MAY enter two consecutive combined test divisions
4. The same horse/rider combination must perform all phases of the competition.
5. **ASTM/SEI approved protective helmets must be worn by riders at all times when mounted.**
6. Wearing of protective vests during the cross-country phase is not required, but is strongly encouraged.
7. USEA medical armbands are recommended during jumping phases but are not required.
8. Dressage test must be ridden from memory and must be ridden in approved snaffle bits.
9. Schooling in the dressage, cross-country, and stadium areas is not permitted.
10. Jumps are provided in warm-up areas and must be jumped in the direction flagged —red flags on your right.
11. Time for walking the stadium course will be provided before each division.
12. A veterinarian will be on call.
13. A farrier will be on grounds.
14. All dogs MUST be leashed while on grounds.
15. This is a non-sanctioned Horse Trials, but run in accordance with USEF/USEA rules.
16. There will be a \$25 charge for lost pinneys.
17. All divisions will be split junior/senior if entries permit.
18. Ride times will be posted on Pony Club website & emailed to all competitors. Ride times will be available after 10PM Thursday before the event.

I understand that a protective helmet secured with a harness/chinstrap must be worn at all times when mounted on grounds. Minors and Pony Club members must wear ASTM/SEI approved helmets. Deep Run Hunt Pony Club strongly suggests the use of Protective Vests when competing in the event. Correct safety gear may prevent serious injury to the rider.
